# Transfer Articulation Agreement between Jarvis Christian College (JCC) And Trinity Valley Community College (TVCC)

Students who transfer to Jarvis Christian College from the Trinity Valley Community College with application to the HBCU-UP SMaRT Program and major in Biology, Chemistry or Mathematics will have their coursework evaluated as follows:

- 1. Those who transfer to Jarvis Christian College and possess an Associate of Science degree (AS) or Associate of Arts Degree (AA) and have completed the Core Curriculum requirements of Trinity Valley Community College (TVCC) and declare a major in biology, chemistry or mathematics will be guaranteed acceptance as a junior and will be deemed to have met the Core Curriculum portion of the graduation requirements at Jarvis Christian College (JCC).
- 2. A student who transfers from TVCC without an Associate Degree but has completed 60 or more credit hours including the TVCC Core Curriculum requirements and declares a major in biology, chemistry or mathematics will be guaranteed acceptance as a junior and will be deemed to have met the Core Curriculum portion of the graduation requirements at JCC.
- 3. A student who transfers from TVCC without an Associate Degree but has completed the TVCC Core Curriculum requirements and declares a major in biology, chemistry or mathematics will be guaranteed acceptance at Jarvis Christian College, and will be deemed to have met the Core Curriculum portion of the graduation requirements at JCC.
- 4. Students transferring to Jarvis Christian College prior to graduating from TVCC are encouraged to consider the advantages of completing the degree by reverse course transfer. Jarvis Christian College will endeavor to provide Trinity Valley Community College with information on transfer students to help Trinity Valley Community College officials determine students that could benefit from reverse transfer of courses.
- 5. Coursework taken to fulfill requirements other than the Core Curriculum will be reviewed by the Registrar and the Division of Arts & Sciences at JCC.
- 6. In addition to satisfying the requirements in 1-4, students transferring to JCC with application to the HBCU-UP SMaRT Program must meet the following Program Requirements to be considered for the SMaRT Scholarship of \$6,000 per academic year:
  - Possess a grade point average of 3.0, or higher, on 4.0 scale,
  - Be a U. S. citizen or permanent resident,
  - Be at least 18 years of age,
  - Have sufficient credit hours completed to qualify as a junior (seniors are not eligible),
  - Submit three (3) letters of recommendation, at least two from your college instructors,
  - Have an absence of serious issues related to conduct and criminal activity,
  - Biology major applicants are expected to have completed two semesters of biology and two semesters of chemistry.
  - Consideration will be given to applicants who have completed four semesters of a combination of biology, chemistry and/or physics.
  - Mathematics major applicants are expected to have completed two semesters of science and at least two semesters of mathematics.
