Following are **quick-facts about the Early Start Summer Program:**

- The **total cost** to attend ESSP is \$3,248; financial aid is available for students who qualify. In most instances, this will cover the cost of tuition for the summer; however, the **2021-2022 FAFSA** must be completed by **May 31, 2022**.
- ESSP students will live in a co-educational living-learning residence hall on JCC's campus.
- ESSP meal plan includes three meals daily, five days a week and two meals (brunch & dinner) on the weekend.
